The HK Haunted Halloween Feis is an indoor event. Social distancing protocols will be followed at all times as outlined by NY state law (<https://forward.ny.gov/>). Facemasks must be worn at all times other than when the dancer is on stage performing (if they choose to remove it). All attendees must maintain a 6 ft. distance between individuals who do not live together in the same household. Feis workers will wear masks. Age groups will be combined in the bun grad competitions to ensure suitable numbers are available for each competition and for scheduling purposes. Championships will be combined as indicated on syllabus.

Pre-Cup Competition:

Open to girls & boys under 7 years of age (1 step) who are not ready to compete at the Bun Grad A level. \$15 per dance.

Reminder: Once you receive a first in a level below, you must progress onto the next level in that particular dance. There must be at least 10 dancers in order for the first to count OR the judge can mark the win as “placement” instead of an “award” in which case the dancer will progress to the next level without the minimum of 10 dancers needed.

Bun Grad A:

Beginner level dancers. NO SOLO COSTUMES ALLOWED. School Costume, Skirt & Blouse, or black leotard (with black tights for u10 and older) ONLY. Dancers will dance 2 Steps. Metronome speeds of 124 for Reel, Hop Jig, and Slip Jig; 116 for Light Jig; 90 for Treble Jig, and 140 for Hornpipe. \$15/dance

SPECIAL AWARD - Bun Grad A Dancer of the Day - The adjudicator will determine the Bun Grad A dancer of the day. To be eligible, you must participate in the reel and light jig. The adjudicator will base his or her decision on a cumulative assessment of these two dances. The dancer of the day is a dancer who has demonstrated superior preparedness in all dances and consistent excellence in Irish Dancing. The Dancer of the Day will receive a sash and special prize.

Bun Grad B:

NO SOLO COSTUMES ALLOWED. School Costume, Skirt & Blouse, or black leotard (with black tights for u10 and older) ONLY. Dancers will dance 40 bars for Reel, Light jig and Treble jig and 32 bars for Slip jig, Hop jig and Hornpipe. Metronome speeds of 116 for Reel & Light Jig, 122 for Hop Jig, 120 for Slip Jig; choice of 88 or 73 for Treble Jig & 138 or 113 for Hornpipe are required. \$15/dance

The adjudicator will base his or her decision on a cumulative assessment of these three dances. The dancer of the day is a dancer who has demonstrated superior preparedness in all dances and consistent excellence in Irish Dancing. The Dancer of the Day will receive a sash and special prize.

Bun Grad C:

NO SOLO COSTUMES ALLOWED. School Costume or black leotard (with black tights for u10 and older) ONLY. Dancers will dance 48 bars for Reel and Treble Jig, 40 bars for Light Jig and 32 bars for Slip Jig, Hornpipe, Hop Jig and Treble reel. Metronome speeds of 113 for Reel and Slip Jig; 116 for Light Jig, 118 for Hop Jig; choice of 88 or 73 for Treble Jig & 138 or 113 for Hornpipe are required. \$15/dance

The dancer of the day is a dancer who has demonstrated superior preparedness in all dances and consistent excellence in Irish Dancing. The Dancer of the Day will receive a sash and special prize.

Pre-Open Solo Rounds:

Advanced Prizewinner/Preliminary dancers (teacher's discretion if any questions). In order to be eligible to dance in the Pre-Open Cup Championships, dancers must compete in at least 2 of the Pre-Open Solo Round dances. Dancers will dance 48 bars for Reel & Treble Jig, and 32 bars for Slip Jig & Hornpipe. Reel, SJ tempo -113, Hard shoe Jig tempo 73, Hornpipe tempo 113. \$15/dance

Open Solo Rounds:

Open Championship dancers. **In order to be eligible to dance in the Open Championships, dancers must compete in at least 2 of the Open Solo round dances.** Dancers will dance 48 bars for Reel & Treble Jig, and 32 bars for Slip Jig & Hornpipe. Reel, SJ tempo -113, Hard shoe Jig tempo 73, Hornpipe tempo 113. \$15/dance

Pre-Open Cup:

Advanced Prizewinner/Preliminary dancers (teacher's discretion if any questions). **In order to be eligible to dance in the Pre-Open Cup Championships, dancers must compete in at least 2 of the Pre-Open Solo Round dances.** Dancers that are still considered Bun Brad C in some dances can still compete in the Pre-Open Cup as long as they are considered Pre-Open in the dances they compete with. Dancers will compete in a 2-round championship consisting of choice of Reel (48 bars) or Slip Jig (32 bars), and Treble Jig (48 bars) or Hornpipe (32 bars). Reel, SJ tempo -113, Hard shoe Jig tempo 73, Hornpipe tempo 113. Hard shoe first. \$25 for Championships.

Open Championships: Open Championship dancers. **In order to be eligible to dance in the Open Championships, dancers must compete in at least 2 of the Open Solo Round dances.** Dancers will compete in a 3-round championship consisting of choice of Reel (48 bars) or Slip Jig (32

bars), Treble Jig (48 bars) or Hornpipe (32 bars), and choice of set. Reel, SJ tempo -113, Hard shoe Jig tempo 73, Hornpipe tempo 113. Hard shoe first. \$35 for Championships.

An Chomhdhail Feis Rules

Competitor card must be worn in the center of the costume. This applies to both boys and girls. Girls choosing to wear a Leotard and skirt must also wear dark tights in Under 10 and older. No solo costumes allowed in Bun Grad A, B and C. Reminder: dancers are allowed to wear until they grow out. Make up cannot be worn until dancers are in the U13 age group. Toe stands begin in September for the U14 age group. Reel, Light Jig, Hop Jig, Treble Jig: 40 bars; Slip Jig, Hornpipe: 32 bars. Pre-Open/Open dancers: In order to compete in a championship, you must compete in at least 2 solo rounds.
